Regina Mary (Keller) Arch Nasatka, 95 of Waldorf, MD, passed away on February 15, 2025 at the University of Maryland Charles Regional Medical Center, La Plata, MD.

Regina was born on April 3, 1929 in Waldorf, MD to Grace (Schlagel) and Leonard J. Keller.

Regina grew up on the family farm. She and her sisters, along with their children worked the farm raising tobacco.
