



Rev. James Lipiano

March 8, 1912 - January 21, 2008

Reverend James Salvatore Lipiano of Clinton, Maryland died on Monday, January 21, 2008 at Bradford Oaks Nursing Home in Clinton, MD. He was 95 years old.

Born on March 8, 1912 in Large, Pennsylvania, he was the son of the late Clara Di Josie and the late Joseph Lipiano. In addition to being a pastor, Rev. James S. Lipiano's ministry included evangelism, counseling, home missions, mentoring, as well as radio and television for nearly the past thirty years. He was the senior chaplain at Southern Maryland Hospital Center where he did visitation as well as held services in the Chapel every Sunday.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife Rose Borda Lipiano.

He is survived by his daughter Lydia C. Lipiano; son James J. Lipiano; sister Virginia Ercolani; brothers Manuel DiJosie and Stanley DiJosie.
