



Rev. Mr. Charles Wilson

September 26, 1934 - December 23, 2007

Charles J. Wilson, 73, of Waldorf, died at his home December 23, 2007. He was an active member of St. Peter's Catholic Church, Waldorf for 42 years. He was an accountant, retiring from MSM Securities in 1998. He was ordained a permanent deacon for the Archdiocese of Washington in January 1975. His many ministries included facilitating the RCIA program, training of lectors, Eucharistic Ministers and altar servers, moderating the teen youth program, and teaching religion classes at St. Peter's. He was actively involved in the American Cancer Society Relay For Life in Newark, DE and Charles County, MD. He was one of the top fundraisers for the Hodgson Relay For Life in Newark for his team 'Mom's Support Crew'. He was chaplain of Ct. St. Peter No. 1618, Catholic Daughters of the Americas.

Charles was born September 26, 1934 in Oklahoma City, OK. He was preceded in death by his wife, Mary Ann Wilson; his parents, Granville Buford and Marguerite Busken Wilson; and his brother, Granville B. Wilson, Jr.

He is survived by his loving children, Bridget Ekhaml and her husband, Stephen, of Charleston, SC; Andrew Wilson and his wife, Christine, of West River, MD; Gerianne McGowan and her husband,
