Richard Allen Bussey Sr. of Silver Spring, Maryland, formerly of Waldorf, MD, died on October 12, 2013 at the Riderwood Village in Silver Spring. He was 75 years old.

Born on March 1, 1938 in Washington, DC, he was the son of the late Evelyn Robey and the late James Edward Bussey Sr. Mr. Bussey, who was affectionately known as "Dick" was a sheet metal foreman with Stromberg Metal Works, Inc.
