Robert Hayden Crawford, Jr., 51, of Mechanicsville, died June 24, 2011, at St. Mary's Hospice House, surrounded by family and friends, after an 8-month battle with Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (Lou Gehrig's disease).
