



## Robert Anthony Petrash

July 22, 1924 - June 5, 2014

Robert Anthony Petrash of Swan Point, MD died on June 5, 2014 at his residence. He was 89 years old.

Robert was the Executive Director of Data Systems with the Association of American Railroads in Washington, DC for 21 years and a member of the Christ Episcopal Church in Wayside, MD. He was a member of the Cobb Island Volunteer Fire Department & EMS and the Mobile Intensive Care Company 60 on Billingsley Road in White Plains, MD – he was the oldest active EMS in the state of Maryland and most highly traveled. He was also a member of the Swan Point Country Club and Wayside Food Bank.

He is the son of the late Anthony Petrash and the late Louise Virginia Bertram Petrash. He is also predeceased by his brother, Raymond Black. He is survived by his wife of 67 years, Naomi M. Petrash; his son, Jeffrey M. Petrash; his sister, Virginia Morell; and his grandson, Michael S. Petrash. He is also survived by eight nieces and nephews.
