



## Robert Emmett Weir

December 7, 1944 - January 8, 2014

Robert Emmett Weir of Waldorf, MD died on January 8, 2014 at his residence. He was 69 years old.

Mr. Weir was a civil engineer technician for 28 years with the Department of Defense (U.S. Government). He was a veteran of the United States Navy, having served from 1961-1966 and a member of the American Legion Post 293 in Waldorf, MD.
