



## Ronald Frederick Jacobs

June 23, 1943 - September 11, 2014

Ronald “Ron” Frederick Jacobs, of Prince Frederick, MD passed away on September 11, 2014, at his home.

Born on June 23, 1943, in Oneida, New York, he was the son of the late Helen Frances (Kemp) and the late Lewis C. Jacobs. He was preceded in death by his brother, Leslie W. Jacobs.

After Ron graduated from Oneida High School in New York, he joined the United States Air Force on August 24, 1962 and served until August 23, 1966. He made his home in the state of Maryland upon his release from active duty.

Ron joined the Prince George’s County Police Department on September 19, 1966 and retired on December 31, 1992, serving 29 years. Since 2000, Ron has managed a shop at the Bargain Barn in Hughesville, Maryland.

Ron attended New Life Church in LaPlata, Maryland. He enjoyed helping others. He also enjoyed playing golf, traveling, attending “Elvis” and “Conway Twitty” Impersonators shows, dancing, baseball, and football games. Ron was a member of the American Legion in Lusby, Maryland; the Moose Lodge in Waldorf, Maryland and the International Police Association (IPA) Baltimore Region 16.
