



Ronald Kerry Johnson

July 18, 1941 - February 7, 2025

Ronald "Kerry" Johnson (83) of Nanjemoy, Maryland died on February 7th, 2025, at Fenwick Landing Assisted Living in Waldorf, MD. He was born in Washington D.C. on July 18th, 1941, as the youngest child of Theodore Johnson Sr. and Georgia Roberta Johnson and graduated from Anacostia Senior High School.
