Ronald Junior Jones, 78, of White Plains, Maryland, passed away on Friday, May 22, 2026 at home surrounded by his loving family.

Born on November 16, 1947, in Maybeury, West Virginia, Ron was the son of the late Amos Walter Jones and Quillar Mae Jones. He graduated from Elkhorn High School in 1965.

Ron proudly served in the United States Army during the Vietnam War and was honorably discharged in 1969 with the rank of Sergeant. During his military service, he received several decorations and honors, including the National Defense Service Medal, Combat Infantryman Badge, Vietnam Service Medal with two Bronze Service Stars, Vietnam Campaign Medal with Device 1960, and the Valorous Unit Award in recognition of extraordinary heroism in combat.

Ron attended Wilkes Community College, where he earned an Associate Degree in Applied Science. He later worked for many years as a diesel mechanic with Penske Corporation.

Ron enjoyed bowling in several leagues, fishing, watching boxing, and spending time with family and friends.

In addition to his parents, Ron was preceded in death by his son, Ronald Anthony Jones, and his siblings: Mary Wagstaff and Dorothy Houston of Washington, D.C.; Geraldine Hairston-Giles and Roy Nathaniel Jones of Virginia; and Darlene Jones and Ruby Sandford of Georgia.

Ron is survived by his wife of 28 years, Carla M. Jones. From his union with Betty Allen, he is also survived by his daughter, Prenetta Tugman, and his son, Donnie Jones; his son-in-law, Broderick Tugman; his daughter-in-law, Jessica Jones; his four grandchildren, Jordan Anthony Jones, Jeremiah Lee Jones, Joshua Taylor Jones, and Jarah Ruby Jones; and his brother, Amos Edward Jones.
