Ryan Edward Stamp, 34, of Waldorf, Maryland, passed away on Tuesday, September 7, 2021 at MedStar Southern Maryland Hospital Center in Clinton.

Born on February 10, 1987 in Clinton, Maryland, he is the son of Donald Edward Stamp and Kathleen Anne Stamp. Ryan graduated from DeMatha Catholic High School in Hyattsville and Mt. St. Mary's University in Emmitsburg, MD. He played in many Southern Maryland baseball leagues and went on to join DeMatha and Mount Saint Mary's teams. Ryan also enjoyed playing golf and watching all kinds of sports, especially the Washington Nationals, Capitols, and Redskins. He worked for the U.S. Secret Service in the Special Services Division as the Assistant Operations Manager for the past 12 years.

In addition to his parents, Ryan is survived by his siblings Erin Jean Stamp and Eric William Stamp.

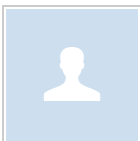

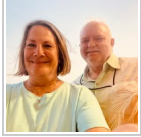
