Samuel Phillips "Phil" Frere of Bel Alton, Maryland, died on Thursday, May 6, 2010 at Civista Medical Center in La Plata, Maryland. He was 86 years old.

Born on August 6, 1923 in Thompkinsville, Maryland, he was the son of the late Mary Phyllis Mudd Frere and the late John Edward Frere. Mr. Frere was a building inspector for the Charles County Government for 20 years. He was a founding father and a 48 year plus member of the Bel Alton Volunteer Fire Department where he served for many years as Treasurer. He was a member of Knights of Columbus Archbishop Neale Council. In his early years, he worked as a bookkeeper for Fort Belvoir Engineering. He was a co-owner of the first self serve grocery store in Charles County (Bel Alton Supermarket). He was a past bookkeeper for Middleton and Higdon Electric. He was a member of St. Ignatius Catholic Church in Chapel Point. He loved gardening.

In addition to his parents, he is preceded in death his brothers Robert Frere, John Edward Frere, Will Joseph Frere, and James Merrick Frere and his sister Marian L. Frere.
