



## Sharon Rose Hendricks

December 24, 1935 - December 18, 2015

Sharon Rose Hendricks, 79, of Charlottesville, VA died December 18, 2015 at home.

Sharon was born on December 24, 1935 in Ottawa, Illinois to the late Charles William Scullin and the late Rose Mary Veale Scullin. She married Robert Lavon Hendricks on February 10, 1957 and they were married for 47 years. Robert passed away on July 8, 2004 in Waldorf, MD, where they lived and raised their children.
