



Spencer Colvett "Spence" Milstead

October 14, 1939 - January 14, 2014

Spencer Colvett Milstead, 74, passed away January 14, 2014 in La Plata, MD due to complications from Parkinson's disease with his family at his side. Born in La Plata on October 14, 1939, he was the son of the late Spencer William Milstead and Annie Laverne Colvett Milstead. His sister, Cora Lou Milstead of Baltimore predeceased him. He leaves his loving wife, Jean Stankewicz Milstead of La Plata; his daughter, Valerie Milstead Daniels of Indian Head and his lovely granddaughters, Vicki and Haley, both also of Indian Head.

After a distinguished 26-year civilian career with the Department of the Navy, Spence became involved with a wide variety of volunteer projects working with Meals on Wheels, women's shelters, adult ESL programs and counseling troubled teens. He spent many years as the Assistant Treasurer and Music Coordinator at Shiloh United Methodist Church in Bryans Road and later his spiritual home became New Life Church in La Plata.

Highly regarded, Spence was a man who gave freely of himself to others. His intelligence, honesty, and integrity set a solid moral example for all those who knew and loved him. In turn, he valued and celebrated those same qualities in others. But he also enjoyed a quick-witted, keen sense of humor in himself and those he spent time with.

In his leisure time, he enjoyed being with family and planning and embarking

on travel adventures with Jean. He also took great pleasure in working outdoors, planting and tending to their garden.

Friends were received on Saturday, January 18, 2014 from 2PM until time of Funeral Services at 3PM at New Life Wesleyan Church (Chapel) with Interment at the church cemetery. 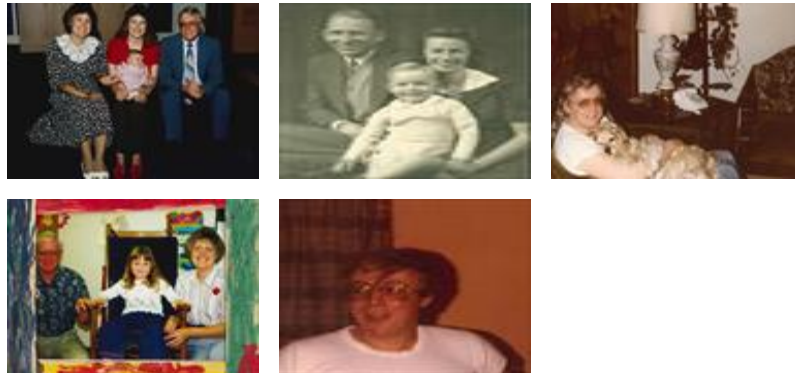
