Steven James Lengquist of Waldorf, Maryland, died on December 5, 2017 at his home. He was 58 years old.

Born on September 9, 1959 in Clear Lake, South Dakota, he was the son of Eleanor Mae Nelson and the late James Edward Lengquist. Steven served in the U. S. Marine Corps until his retirement in 2013 at the rank of Lieutenant Colonel. He then worked at the Pentagon as an Explosive Safety Specialist. He also loved to ride his Harley Davidson motorcycle, especially in charitable runs, such as the Toys for Tots, Poker Run for Charlotte Hall Veterans Home and many others.
