Susie Blanche Willett of Bryans Road, MD (formerly of Accokeek, MD), died on Tuesday, April 22, 2014 at her residence. She was 98 years old.

Born on January 26, 1916, she was the daughter of the late Blanche S. Pickeral and the late Frank Penn. Mrs. Willett was a cafeteria worker for the Prince George's County Board of Education and received the Outstanding Service Award from the Board. A life-long member of Christ Episcopal Church in Accokeek, she served on the church auxiliary for over 39 years.
