Tamara Elaine Short of Hughesville, MD died on Tuesday, January 31, 2012 at Burnett-Calvert Hospice House in Prince Frederick, MD. She was 49 years old.

Mrs. Short was a Special Agent for 18 years with the Air Force Office of Special Investigations (AFOSI) most recently assigned at Bolling AFB.
