



## Thomas Francis Crosby II

October 19, 1944 - August 8, 2021

Thomas Francis Crosby II, age 76 of Waldorf, Maryland, died on August 8, 2021.

Thomas was a Journeyman Pressman for 55 years at McDonald and Eudy Printers and a veteran of the U.S. Marine Corps. He was a member of Good Shepherd United Methodist Church in Waldorf, Maryland where he was also a member of the United Methodist Men and a Trustee of the church. He was a self-taught guru of IT training, played on Parks and Rec sports teams, an excellent sous chef, a notary, a top person networker, and a community advocate.

He was the son of Henry Clement Crosby and Patricia Dunnigan. In addition to his parents, he is predeceased by his son, Scott Dunnigan Crosby; his brother, Robert Crosby; and his sister, Rita Crosby.

He is survived by his wife, Linda Kefauver Crosby; his daughter, Erin M. Crosby-Neaves; his sisters, Ellen O'Hara, Regis Crosby, Patricia Crosby, and Eileen Crosby; and his grandchildren, Adam Crosby, Alexandra Neaves, Austin Neaves, and Analena Crosby.
