



## Thomas Joseph DeCurtis

May 16, 1953 - January 18, 2015

Thomas Joseph DeCurtis of La Plata, Maryland, died on Sunday, January 18, 2015 at Langley Air Force Base Hospital in Virginia. He was 62 years old.

Born on May 16, 1953 in Bronx, New York, he was the son of the late Veronica Heatherington DeCurtis and the late Vincent DeCurtis. Mr. DeCurtis served in the U. S.
