



Thomas Cleota Langdon

May 6, 1934 - September 15, 2014

Thomas Cleota Langdon of Myrtle Beach, South Carolina, formerly of Waldorf, MD, died on September 15, 2014 in Myrtle Beach. He was 80 years old.

Born on May 6, 1934 in Washington, DC, he was the son of the late Lillian and Cleota Langdon. Mr. Langdon served in the U. S. Army during the Korean War. Following the Korean War, he served in the Army National Guard as a Special Forces Green Beret. Mr. Thomas Langdon was a retired Maryland State Trooper. He was an active member of the V.F.W. and was Past Worshipful Master of the Perseverance Masonic Lodge in Indian Head, MD. He was a very loving father, grandfather and great grandfather who loved his country and was proud to be an American.

In addition to his parents, Thomas Langdon was preceded in death by his son Mark T. Langdon and his grandson Cody Langdon.

He is survived by his wife of 57 years, Gladys Langdon; his daughters Sharron M. Winkler of White Plains, MD and Brenda D. Arnold of Myrtle Beach, SC; his son Michael D.
