



Thomas Edward McManus

March 26, 1933 - December 18, 2015

Thomas Edward “Tom” McManus of Waldorf, Maryland, died on Friday, December 18, 2015 at the University of Maryland Charles Regional Medical Center in La Plata. He was 82 years old.

Born on March 26, 1933 in Brooklyn, New York, he was the son of the late Dorothy F. McManus and the late V. Paul McManus. Mr. McManus served in the U. S. Air Force for four years before being Honorably Discharged in 1954. He graduated from Georgetown University and worked as an accountant for the U. S. Postal Service in Washington, DC. He was a member of the American Legion and of NARFE. Mr. McManus was an active member of the Knights of Columbus, Dr. John H. Griffin Council 2293 where he was a Fourth Degree Knight, Past Grand Knight and Past District Deputy. He was of the Catholic faith and attended St. Peter’s Catholic Church in Waldorf.

In addition to his parents, Mr. McManus was preceded in death by his brother Paul D. McManus.

He is survived by his wife Barbara A. McManus; children Thomas P. McManus, Catherine A. Brashear and her husband Christopher; grandchildren Nicholas, Amanda and Bradley; siblings Mary J. Strackbein and John F. “Jack” McManus.

A visitation will be held on Wednesday, December 23, 2015 from 10AM until for Mass to begin at 11AM at St. Peter's Catholic Church 3320 St. Peter's Church Road Waldorf, MD 20601.
