



Timothy Gerald Moore

November 29, 1942 - April 4, 2024

Timothy Gerald “Tim” Moore, age 81, passed away on April 4 at his home in Port Tobacco, Maryland.

Tim and his identical twin brother, Tom, were born on November 29, 1942, in Columbus, Ohio, to Catherine and Tom Moore. He was a loud and proud alumnus of Aquinas College High School and The Ohio State University and a diehard fan of the Buckeyes.

Tim served six years in the U.S. Army Reserve as he embarked on a nearly 50-year career in the financial sector, where he made his mark designing student loan repayment programs and was active in several national associations in his field. Highly regarded for his integrity, work ethic, and dedication to his customers, many of Tim’s colleagues sought out his mentorship.

In 1965, Tim married Rosalyn Wolf, and they raised four children together. In 1977, Tim and Rose moved their young family from Westerville, Ohio, to Port Tobacco. Tim became deeply involved in his family’s new community, volunteering his time and energy to various organizations and their church, St. Ignatius at Chapel Point. Tim was a member of the Knights of Columbus and served as Grand Knight of the Neale Council and as District Deputy, among other roles.

Tim's most cherished roles were those of husband, father, and grandfather. He loved golf, football, and baseball, and his favorite days were spent with his family cheering on the Buckeyes and the Orioles.

A big guy both in stature and personality, Tim told great stories and enjoyed sharing a good laugh. His faith-filled, honest, and loving nature put people at ease: Tim never met a stranger, and he made everyone feel like an old friend.

Tim is survived by his wife of 59 years, Rosalyn (née Wolf); daughter Catherine Johnson (Jonathan); sons Brian and Scott (Mariah); grandchildren Jared (Miranda), Ayden, Samantha, James, and Paisley; sister Kathleen; many loving sisters- and brothers-in-law, nieces, nephews, and cousins; and so many friends. He is preceded in death by his son Kevin, his parents, and his brothers Tom, and P.J.
