December 15, 1955 - December 18, 2020

Timothy Lee Pasternak, 65, of Port Tobacco, Maryland, passed away on December 18, 2020 at his home.

Born on December 15, 1955 in Weston, West Virginia, he was the son of Lorena G. Pasternak and the late Joseph T. Pasternak. Fondly known as Tim and Turtle, he served in the U. S. Navy during Operation Desert Storm until he was Honorably Discharged in 1995. Tim worked as an aircraft mechanic for DynCorp International for 20+ years. Tim loved his family and friends and went out of his way for each and everyone. He loved history, especially the Civil War era, visiting museums, the Beatles, the Washington Senators (Nationals) baseball team, going to yard sales and finding the most unusual items. Tim earned the nickname “The Yard Sale King” because of his many incredible finds.

In addition to his father, he was preceded in death by his nephew Jason Pasternak.

In addition to his mother Lorena, Tim is survived by his daughter Christina M. McGann, son in-law Ryan McGann, son Jeremy L. Pasternak; brother Joseph R. “Joey” Pasternak and his wife Susan; niece Bonnie Shoemaker, her husband Rick and great niece Katie and great nephew CJ; his former wife Wanda Pasternak; and two fur grandbabies.

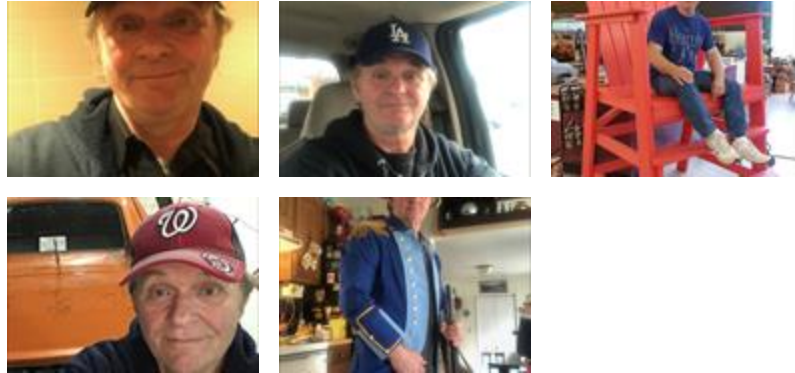

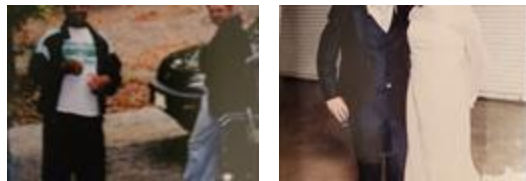

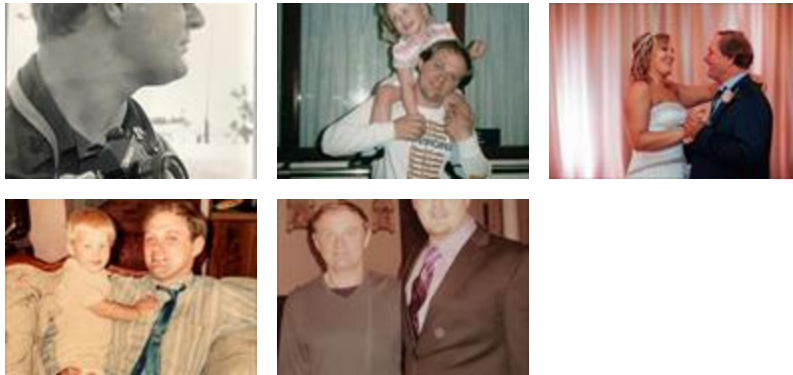
