Virgil Edwin Ball, age 64 of Waldorf, Maryland died November 12, 2016 at Southern Maryland Hospital Center in Clinton, Maryland.

Virgil was a Postal Clerk for 36 years with the U.S. Postal Service. He was a history buff, especially Civil War and World War II. He enjoyed reading (Louis Lamour), western movies (John Wayne), playing chess and loved to watch the Washington Redskins. He was also a supporter of the Philippine Association of the Metropolitan Washington Engineers (PAMWE). Virgil was known as a very kind person with a gentle soul, kind heart and was very generous. He was always willing to help others – he never thought twice about helping others. Everyone who knew him looked up to him and admired him. “He was one in a million with a heart of gold.”
