Wallace Reed Simms, 79, of Waldorf, MD, died March 4, 2010, at Chesapeake Shores Nursing Center, Lexington Park, MD.

Mr. Simms was in the United States Army in the Korean era and was a self-employed musician (lead guitar, saxophone, fiddle) for 40 years. He started playing music in 1948 in Ohio, moved to Washington, DC to play music in 1958. He played and lived in P.G. County from 1969 through 1988 and has lived in Charles County since 1988.
