Wanda Howard Boley, age 82, passed away peacefully on Saturday, June 5, 2021 in La Plata, Maryland. She was born on March 22, 1939 in Alva, Kentucky to Mary and Ralph Howard. She was the oldest of five children. After graduating from Black Star High School in 1957, she moved to Washington DC to work as a Fingerprint Typist at the FBI. She met the love of her life, Dan M.
