William Thomas “Tommie” Biggs, Jr., age 76 of La Plata, MD, died on March 11, 2015 at the Southern MD Hospital Center in Clinton, MD.

Tommie was a life-long farmer and operated a produce stand in Camp Springs, MD. He was a long-time member of the Charles County Farm Bureau. He liked to travel and eat out. He was known as a hard worker – he worked till the day of his death.
