“ It's a sad day.....a very sad day. Billy was such a powerful force, quietly doing good, helping everyone. It seems anyone he met became a friend, never just an acquaintance.....you - the family - know some of how he took care of me during the incredibly rough times when my mom was hospitalized in Georgetown Hospital for several months, and then when my daughter was battling leukemia. He was my angel, and I don't know how I could have gotten through these times without his friendship. I was, many nights a week, returning home between 11 pm and midnight, after a long day of work, then visiting either my mom or daughter far away in a hospital. Certainly I was not fixing dinner at that hour - and Billy would call me on my way down the road, tell me he had something little for me to eat, and we would meet at the old White House Hotel at the corner of Rt. 301 and 234, at that late hour....there, I'd be greeted by Billy, with a couple of his big bear hugs, and some freshly fried chicken (his was the best!), and usually a piece of one of his excellent cakes, and sometimes some of his homemade ice cream.....He made sure I ate well, and was safe on the roads, and he was an incredible friend. I don't know of anyone else who would fry chicken at 11 pm and then drive several miles to deliver it....sometimes I'd arrive home and find a bag of sweet potatoes on the porch, or some other garden delight. And of course, he'd magically appear at my house while I was at work, and sharpen my mower blades; and once he finished putting new shingles on my old shed - needless to say, his part of the shed roof looks way better than the part I did!.....he just saw the needs and took care of them..... we enjoyed many a church dinner over the years!! and so many Friday night dinners at the Legion. Anyone keeping company with him ate very well~~.....and since we both love bluegrass music, we attended quite a few events with our music friends. He, and the rest of the family, are such gems.....The hole in my heart is deep, and it will not be filled.....
