William "Bill" Earnest Montgomery, 71 of La Plata, MD died suddenly on Tuesday, December 2, 2014 at Washington Hospital Center.

He was born July 9, 1943 in La Plata, MD to the late Leo Sisco and Violet Nutwell Montgomery.

He was the Chairman and Professor of Biological and Physical Sciences at College of Southern Maryland (CSM). Bill received Nemours awards for his work and several service awards from CSM. He was a member of St. Mary's Newport Catholic Church.
