William Theodore "Bill" Duryea, 67, of La Plata, MD died on September 21, 2014 at the Charlotte Hall Veterans Home.

Born on October 20, 1946 in Great Barrington, MA, he was the eldest son of the late Theodore and June Duryea of South Egremont, MA. After graduating from Mount Everett High School, Bill joined the Air Force and served in Vietnam as a Ground Radio Operations Supervisor.
