William Harry, 87, of Charlotte Hall, formerly of Oxon Hill, MD, died March 26, 2011, at St. Mary's Hospital, Leonardtown, MD.

Mr. Harry was an electrician supervisor for 37 years with the Bureau Printing and Engraving and a veteran of the United States Army having served during World War II.
