William Ralph Whalen "Bill" Mudd of Faulkner, MD died on May 18, 2014 at his residence with Hospice on the same family farm where he was born on January 26, 1938. He was 76 years old.

He was predeceased by his wife, Pamela E. Mudd and his parents, Claude E. Mudd and Virginia Mary Whalen Mudd.

He is survived by his daughters, Patricia Mudd McDonald and her husband Ferris of Edgewater, Elizabeth Mudd DeLabar and her husband Dan of La Plata, and Peggy A. 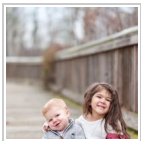
