January 30, 1935 - March 3, 2012

William Raymond Slack of Largo, Florida, formerly of Waldorf, Maryland, died on Saturday, March 3, 2012 in Largo, FL. He was 77 years old.

Born January 30, 1935 in Brooklyn, New York, he was the son of the late Mary Winifred Faulkner and the late Charles Escar Slack. He served in the U. S. Army during the Korean War before being Honorably Discharge in 1960. Mr. Slack then worked for 29 years at the Government Printing Office. As a member of the Columbia Typographical Union 101-12, Mr. Slack was a dedicated union man for over 50 years. He strongly believed in fighting for workers rights and this lead him to serve as Chapel Chairman for over 10 years. He affectionately earned the nickname "Battling Bill Slack". Mr. Slack was a member of the Mechanicsville Moose Lodge 495-444 and a former deacon at his church. He loved traveling, dancing, reading, walking on the beach, but especially loved spending time with his grandchildren and great grandchildren.

In addition to his parents, he is preceded in death by his wife Rose Marie Reilly Slack; his siblings Barbara Keegan, Bernard Slack, Marie Gillen, Charles Slack, Ann Dice, John Slack, Mary Slack; and his grandson Justin Slack.
